Mi-ACCES Annual Conference Business Meeting
June 8, 2006
11 a.m. - Noon

- President Mike Erwin, Eastern Michigan University - overview of what had been accomplished by Mi-ACCES in the past year, and thanked all who had been involved with the organization.
- Past President Bob Thomas, Oakland University – annual summary of the outcomes of the Mi-ACCES sponsored virtual job fairs.
- 2006-2007 Election of Officers, 2006-2007:

- Organization Name Change: Mi-ACCES to Mi-ACE (Michigan Association of Colleges & Employers)
- Incoming President, Jim Novak, gave an overview of plans for the 2006-2007 year including Virtual Job Fairs, Board Meetings, and Vendor Analysis.
- Ginger Lange, Treasurer, reported that there were 98 members for 2005-2006 and individuals have joined since then. The account balance \$18,290 with conference receipts and few conference expense payments made to date.
- Annual Conference 2007 Discussion:
 - Jack Crusoe, Michigan Collegiate Job Fair, suggested that the “Morrison Circle” (business card exchange) be used, providing a specific time for employers and college staff to interact.
 - “Career Services – Services to business to look for talent”...tie in with Phil’s “Recruiting Trends” Report. (Jack Crusoe)
 - Suggestion made to send electronic flyers to the college members who could distribute them to their employers as a means of publicizing the next conference.
 - Kelly Bishop, Michigan State University, mentioned that Phil Gardner will present “Recruiting Trends” during the 3rd week of November, 2006, in Chicago. A Michigan’s version of Gardner’s data would likely be of interest to members. It might be part of a regional program held in Lansing after the Chicago event.
- Plaques were given to Mike Erwin and Bob Thomas in recognition of their service as organization presidents. Ginger Lange gave gifts to conference committee members. The gifts were certificates (payment of 2007 Mi-ACE Conference fees).
